Let's start this fall by welcoming all of our new families, and watching a few of our friends move on to Caterpillar Land.

The first week of school was dedicated solely to exploring the new environment, getting to know one another, and observing interests. The children have all been very interested in talking about colors and shapes. So, we started the second week of school by creating a web. You can see the webs we create on are bulletin board near the door in our classroom, as well as, our daily schedule and daily planning sheet which shows the activates we work on each day.

We have been busy Pandas! We have made green play dough, melted crayons on a hot plate, and painted with a variety of tools, including our hands, fingers, Q-tips, paintbrushes, and circles from our shape sorter. You can find our art displayed on the wall, or in your child's art file, which is located just above the cubbies.

We are learning how to hold crayons and markers, as well as, replacing the caps when we are done using them. We are also learning to assemble puzzles after we dump them out, and are practicing clean up in general.



Happy Fall Everyone!




The school year is in full swing, and we are all having so much fun exploring our new class and getting to know each other better.
